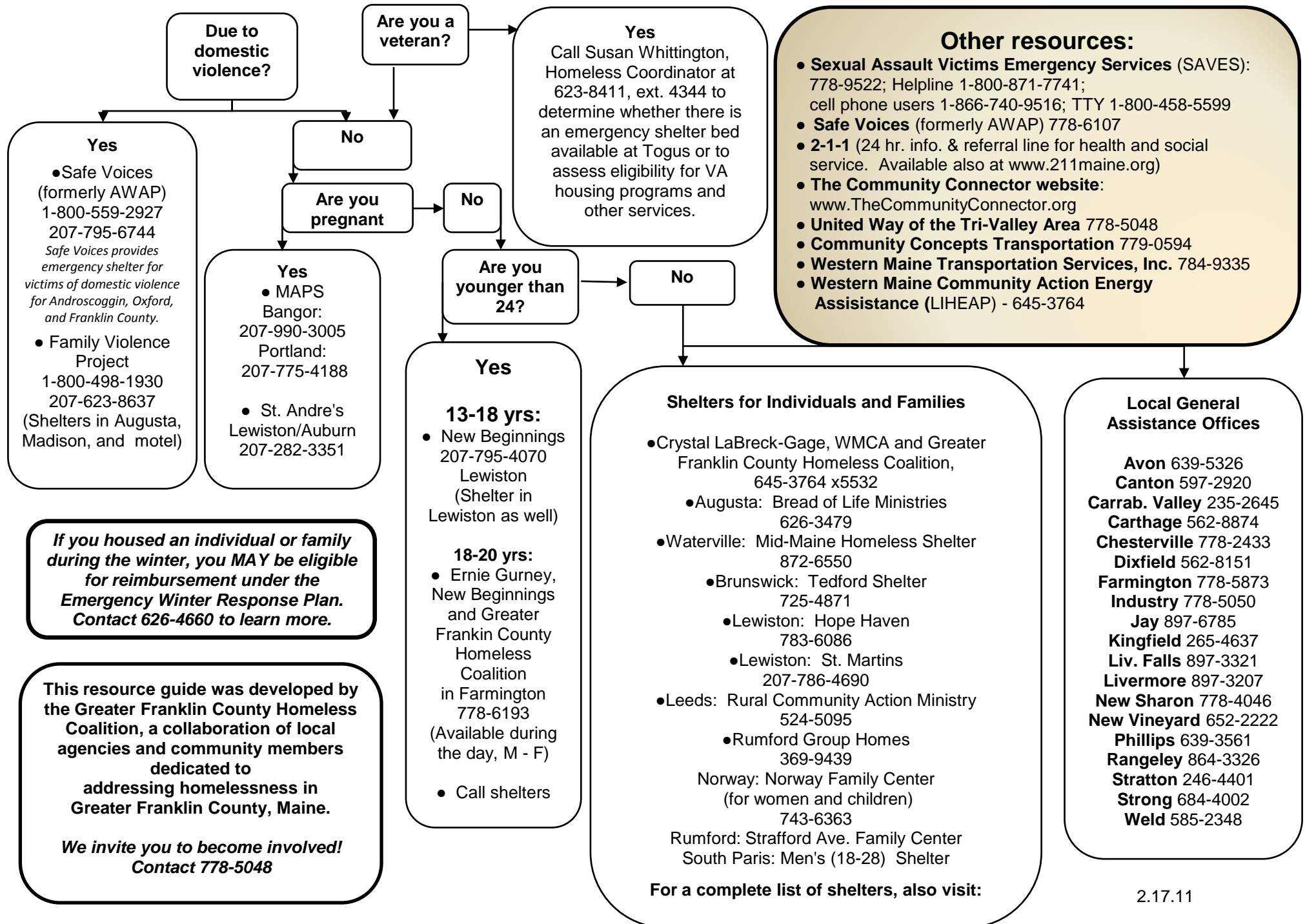


# Are you, or someone you know, homeless or at risk of being homeless?
