Resource Room Coordination

- Inventory available resources in current storage area
- Improve system to quickly access items when requested
- Seek community donations to fill emergency needs (e.g. bedding, beds, small furniture items, towels, hygiene items such as soap and shampoo)
- Assist community members with requests
- Explore alternative storage facility in downtown Farmington

United Way Marketing Materials Development

- Write short pieces using information gained in the interview. Articles to appear in regional publications, and on UWTVA website
