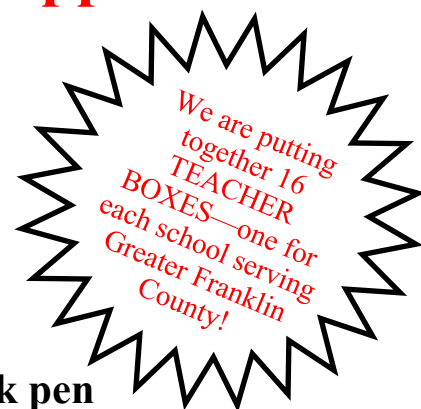


# Tools for Teachers
